Re: All Kitec® Claim Deadlines Extended; Homeowners to ACT NOW, Limited Funds Available

Dear Clark County Plumbing Contractor:

Total Class Solutions, LLC (“TCS”) is the Court-appointed claims administrator in the *In re Kitec Fitting Litigation*, Case No. A493302. As a plumbing contractor in Clark County, Nevada, you are likely aware of this class action case involving the defective Kitec® brass fittings. Many Clark County homeowners with Kitec® fittings in their homes may not be aware of this information. Plumbing contractors are often the first responders for Kitec® class members after a fitting has failed and/or leaked. Over the years, many Clark County plumbers have informed the Kitec® homeowners of the class action litigation, and this has helped the homeowners receive the settlement relief to which they were entitled. We appreciate your efforts to alert and assist the homeowners.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that the Court has **extended all deadlines for Kitec® class members in Clark County to file claims** requesting the available settlement relief. All prior bars to claims have been lifted. Homeowners now have **three (3) years to file claims** for the available settlement relief, **until approximately March 2017, or until the available funds have been exhausted**. The remaining **funds are a limited**, and claims will be handled on a **first-come, first-served basis**. Once the funds are exhausted, all claims will be rejected.

As you are out working in the community, we ask that you please direct all Kitec® homeowners to our office for more information regarding the available settlement relief. Should you service a home with a broken Kitec® fitting, we ask that you leave the fitting with the homeowner to facilitate any future claim by the homeowner.
