

Dear Kitec Class Members:

The purpose of this email is to request that all Kitec class members who have had a re-plumb repair of their home provide Class Counsel with the following information:

- (1) Homeowner name;
- (2) Address of home where re-plumb occurred;
- (3) Name of community where home is located;
- (4) Documentary confirmation from plumbing company that home had the Kitec plumbing system;
- (5) Date re-plumb repair occurred;
- (6) Date of Kitec fitting failure, if any; and
- (7) The total cost for the re-plumb repair.

Class Counsel has been ordered to provide this information to the Special Master overseeing this case. Accordingly, Class Counsel requests that this information be provided by October 15, 2007. This information can be provided to Class Counsel in one of the following ways:
