GOOD NEWS – PER HOME CREDIT INCREASE

URGENT – ACT NOW OR FORFEIT \$2,650-\$5,400 IN SETTLEMENT RELIEF

Dear Homeowner,

The purpose of this letter is to follow up on the Initial Settlement Notice sent to you in August 2011 indicating that you may be entitled to a Per Home Credit of approximately \$1,750 to \$4,450 as a contribution towards the cost of replumbing the **defective Kitec plumbing system that may be installed in your home**. Our records indicate you did not submit a **Claim Form** in response to the Initial Notice, which is the reason you have received this letter.

The Good News is that the Per Home Credit contribution as outlined in the Initial Notice has been **increased by \$915.70**. This means the settlement will now pay for an additional \$915.70 toward the replumb of your home, which means you now may be entitled to approximately \$2,650 to \$5,400. There may be a further increase in the Per Home Credit, but the amount and timing of another potential increase is unknown at this time.

With such a substantial increase in the Per Home Credit, we hope that you will now consider completing your **Claim Form** and submitting it to the Claims Administrator so that you may receive the replumb. To participate in this Class Action settlement, you must complete and return the enclosed **Claim Form**.

URGENT: The deadline for sending in your **Claim Form** is **October 31st 2012** (Postmark Date) – after which date **you will forfeit all of the benefits** to which you are entitled. At a minimum, you **MUST submit a Claim Form** electing the “Replumb Later” option by this deadline **to preserve your rights** to receive any of the Kitec settlement relief. Submitting a **Claim Form** now does not compel you to accept the replumb. If you submit a timely **Claim Form**, then you will have until early April 2013 to elect whether to replumb your home.
